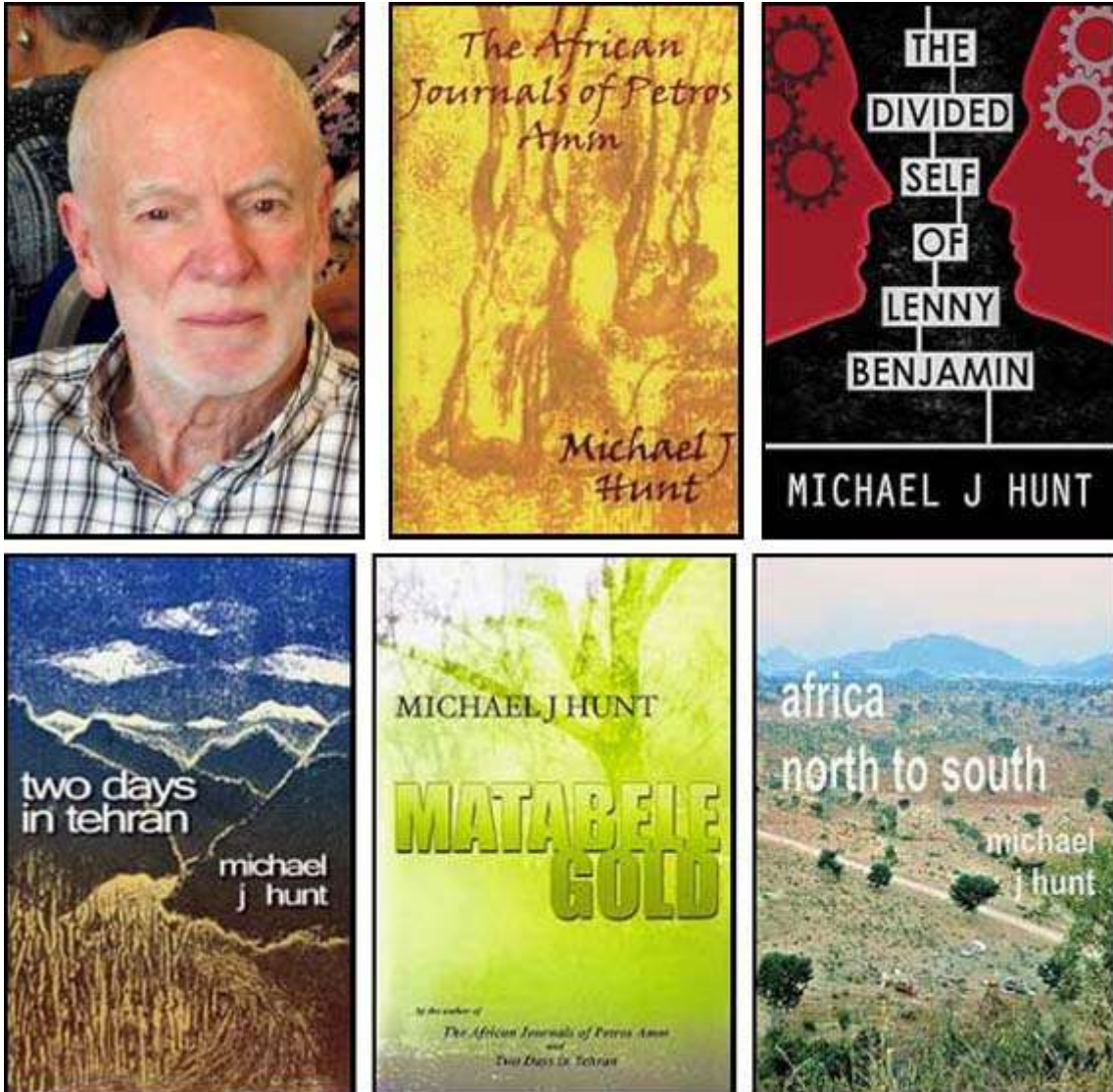


Michael Hunt

Michael Hunt is another of our Nypol members to take up pen and paper to produce a collection of novels. So far he has completed the underlisted but there is a sixth in the pipeline which will feature “happenings in Malawi”.

Michael was resident in Nyasaland/Malawi from 1956 to 1969. he was employed by the APMB growing tobacco in the Central Region for fourteen months before working in the Standard Bank in Blantyre, Zomba and Lilongwe. He was a Reserve Constable, then Inspector, from 1958 before leaving Malawi in 1969,. A Probation Officer in UK he retired in the early 2000's. In 1988 he suffered a total paralysis - Guillain Barre Syndrome - and had to find a non-physical activity, which led him, via a creative writing course, to his current novel writing. Beginning with historical themes, set in Africa, he used his own travelling and work experiences to create this series of adventure/thriller type stories.
